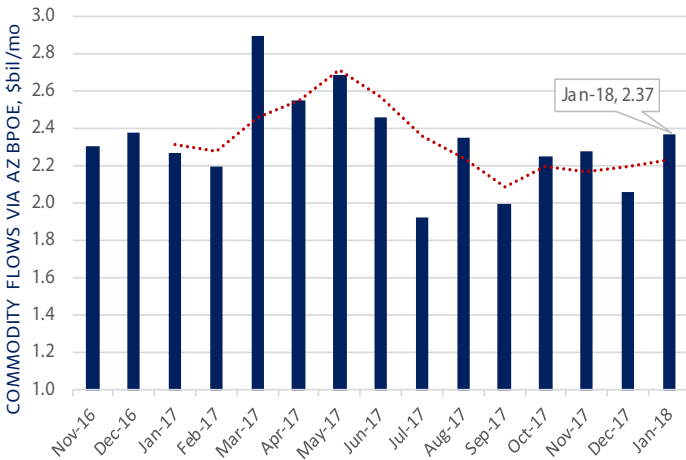

AZ EXPORTS TO MEXICO

the average \$ value for latest three months of data, Nov-17 to Jan-18, is **down 0.5%** from the average for the previous three-months, and is **0.3% lower** than a year ago.

Arizona merchandise exports to Mexico hit \$7.6 billion in calendar year 2017, down 8.6% from 2016.

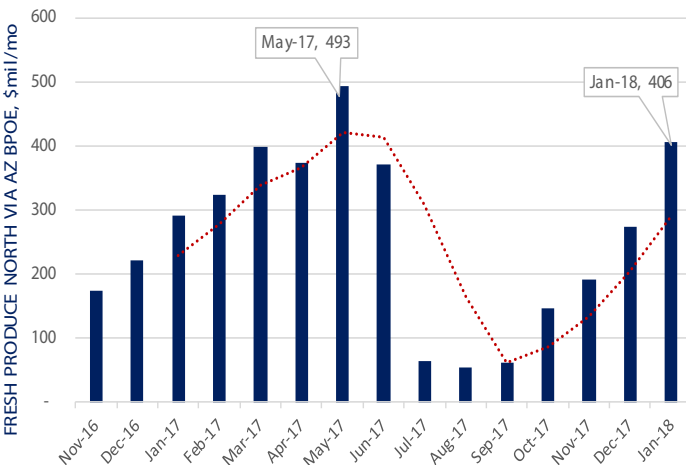

COMMODITY FLOWS US/MEXICO VIA AZ BPOE

the average \$ value for latest three months of data, Nov-17 to Jan-18, is **up 1.7%** from the average for the previous three-months, and is **3.5% less** than a year ago.

Trade flows (northbound & southbound) between the U.S. and Mexico traveling via Arizona BPOE reached \$27.9 billion in calendar year 2017, down 7.5% from 2016.

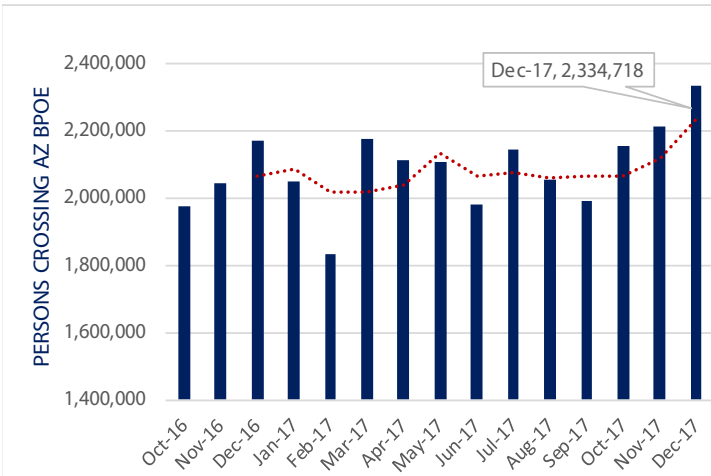

FRESH PRODUCE VIA AZ BPOE

the average \$ value for latest three months of data, Nov-17 to Jan-18, is **up 232.8%** from the the previous three-months, and is **up 26.6%** from a year ago.

U.S. fresh produce imports from Mexico through Arizona BPOE were valued at \$3.0 billion in calendar year 2017, down 6.4% from 2016.

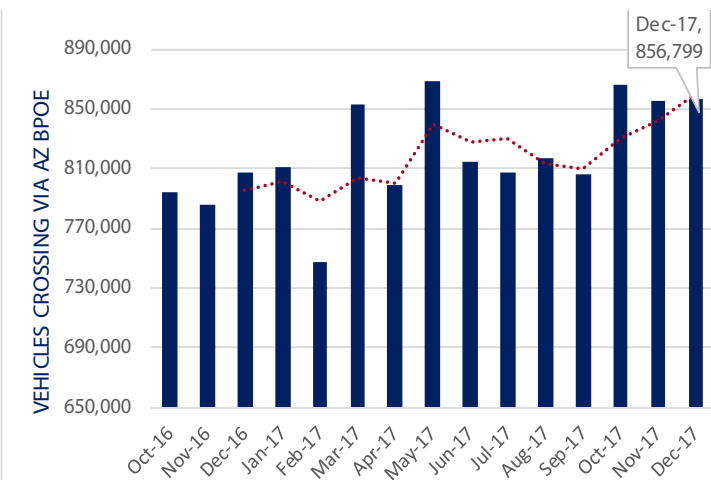

PERSONS CROSSING AZ BORDER NORTHBOUND

the average number for latest three months of data, Oct-Dec 2017, is **up 8.3%** from the previous three-month average, and is **8.3% higher** than a year ago.

Last year 25.1 million people crossed from Mexico to the U.S. through Arizona BPOE, a 5.5% increase from 2016.

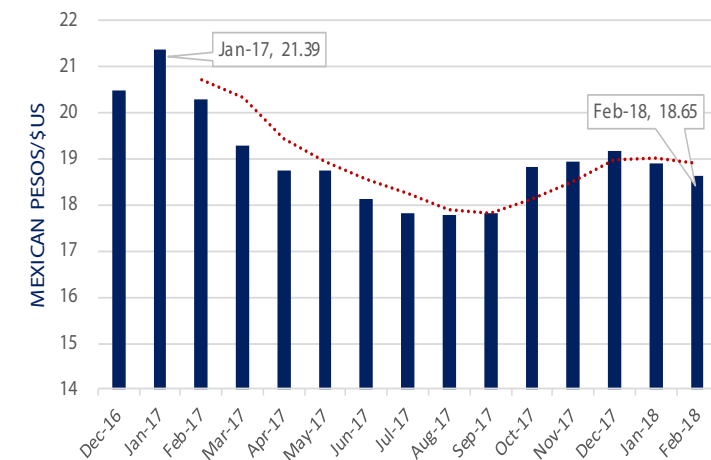

VEHICLES CROSSING AZ BORDER NORTHBOUND

the average number for latest three months of data, Oct-Dec 2017, is **up 6.1%** from the previous three-month average, but is **8.0% higher** than a year ago.

In 2017, 9.9 million vehicles crossed from Mexico to the U.S. through Arizona BPOE, up 6.9% from 2016.

EXCHANGE RATE

the average exchange rate for the last three months of data, Dec-17 to Feb-18, is a **2.1% increase** in the peso's value over the average for the previous three months, and a **9.6% decline** from a year ago.

On average for 2017, the dollar rose 1.3% against the peso. However, since 2014, the dollar has appreciated by 42.1%.
