



Arizona Exports to Mexico

up **15.3**% from 2020 Q4

Arizona exports to Mexico increased year-over-year for four consecutive quarters.


Total U.S. Trade through Arizona BPOE

Fresh Produce Imports via Arizona BPOE



Persons Crossing Arizona Border (Northbound)





Persons crossing the Arizona-Mexico border reached a significant low in April 2020, due to travel restrictions related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Border crossings continue to trend up, although still down from pre-COVID levels.

Vehicles Crossing Arizona Border (Northbound)





Personal vehicle and bus border crossings continue to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic, with Q4 2021 vehicle crossings exceeding Q4 2019. Commercial truck traffic remains steady.
