



#### Arizona Exports to Mexico

#### Total U.S. Trade through Arizona BPOE



#### Fresh Produce Imports via Arizona BPOE





Persons crossing the Arizona-Mexico border through Arizona BPOE reached a significant low in April 2020, due to travel restrictions related to the pandemic. While travel has increased significantly, it is still not back to pre-pandemic levels.


