



Arizona Exports to Mexico



AZ EXPORTS TO MEXICO **\$2.1 billion** in 2019 Q2, up 13.6% from 2018 O2

While still below peak levels reached in 2015-2016, Arizona exports to Mexico have continued Y/Y gains throughout 2019.

Total U.S. trade TO/FROM MEXICO VIA AZ BPOE \$8.2 billion total goods crossing the border in 2019 Q2 up 14.2% from 2018 O2

Commodities flowing via Arizona BPOE are approaching 2013 highs, reversing a downward trend since 2014.

📕 Vehicle Traffic (Personal Vehicles + Buses) 📕 Truck Traffic


