


#### Arizona Exports to Mexico




## AZ **EXPORTS**

Arizona exports to Mexico have declined over the previous year for three consecutive quarters. The COVID-19 pandemic significantly disrupted Arizona's exports to Mexico in the second quarter of 2020, with a double-digit drop.





#### Persons Crossing Arizona Border (Northbound)




# 2.1 million PERSONS CROSSING AZ BORDER NORTHBOUND

Persons crossing the Arizona-Mexico border reached a significant low in April 2020, due to travel restrictions related to the COVID-19 pandemic. With only marginal recovery in May and June, 2020 Q2 people crossings were less than half of 2019 Q2...

## 1.1 million VEHICLES CROSSING AZ BORDER NORTHBOUND

in 2020 Q2 down **51.1**% from 2019 Q2

Personal vehicle and bus border crossings are down significantly due to travel restrictions related to the COVID-19 pandemic. However, commercial truck traffic remains resilient and is consistent in year-over-year analysis.
