


### Arizona Exports to Mexico

Arizona commodity exports to Mexico decreased again in the second quarter to sink below 2019 levels.


Total U.S. Trade Through Arizona BPOE

up 2.8% from 2022 Q2


Total trade flows (exports + imports) through Arizona border ports are well above pre-pandemic levels.

U.S. imports of fresh produce through Arizona ports exhibit strong seasonality, with highs in the winter and spring.




# 5.8 million PERSONS CROSSING AZ BORDER NORTHBOUND

Persons crossing the Arizona-Mexico border through Arizona BPOE reached a significant low in April 2020, due to travel restrictions related to the pandemic. Travel has recovered to pre-pandemic levels.






## 2.5 million VEHICLES CROSSING AZ BORDER NORTHBOUND

Personal vehicle and bus border crossings recovered gradually from the pandemic shock. Commercial truck traffic rebounded very rapidly.
