


## **Arizona Exports to Mexico**

Arizona commodity exports to Mexico increased in the first quarter but slightly declined over the year.


## Total U.S. Trade Through Arizona BPOE

# Fresh Produce Imports via Arizona BPOE



### Persons Crossing Arizona Border (Northbound)




# 5.9 million PERSONS CROSSING AZ BORDER NORTHBOUND

Persons crossing the Arizona-Mexico border through Arizona BPOE reached a significant low in April 2020, due to travel restrictions related to the pandemic. Travel has recovered to pre-pandemic levels.
