



Arizona Exports to Mexico

Arizona commodity exports to Mexico have risen to new heights in the third quarter.


Total U.S. Trade Through Arizona BPOE



U.S. imports of fresh produce through Arizona ports exhibit strong seasonality, with highs in the first and second quarters.






6.0 million PERSONS CROSSING AZ BORDER NORTHBOUND

Persons crossing the Arizona-Mexico border through Arizona BPOE reached a significant low in April 2020, due to travel restrictions related to the pandemic. Travel has recovered to pre-pandemic levels.

Vehicles Crossing Arizona Border (Northbound)




