



### **Arizona Exports to Mexico**

Arizona commodity exports to Mexico decreased again in the first quarter but remain above their pre-pandemic levels.


### Total U.S. Trade Through Arizona BPOE

Total trade flows (exports + imports) through Arizona border ports are well above pre-pandemic levels.


#### Fresh Produce Imports via Arizona BPOE



Persons crossing the Arizona-Mexico border through Arizona BPOE reached a significant low in April 2020, due to travel restrictions related to the pandemic. Travel has recovered to pre-pandemic levels.


