



### **Arizona Exports to Mexico**

Arizona commodity exports to Mexico have increased for three consecutive quarters and are well above their pre-pandemic level.


### **Total U.S. Trade through Arizona BPOE**

Total trade flows (exports + imports) through Arizona border ports are well above pre-pandemic levels.


### Fresh Produce Imports via Arizona BPOE



Persons crossing the Arizona-Mexico border through Arizona BPOE reached a significant low in April 2020, due to travel restrictions related to the pandemic. While travel has increased significantly, it is still not back to pre-pandemic levels.






# 2.5 million VEHICLES CROSSING AZ BORDER NORTHBOUND
